TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIP

Our transfer scholarship is awarded competitively and offers students up to \$4,000 per year for students enrolled in fall and spring coursework.

REQUIREMENTS

To be considered, applicants must:

- → Have completed 27–75 transferable college credit hours with a minimum 3.5 cumulative GPA
- > Have completed at least one full-time semester (12+ hours) at an accredited college or university
- > Have been enrolled at an accredited institution within the past academic year
- Have met all remediation requirements
- > Submit official transcripts reflecting GPA and credit hours by the scholarship deadline

You must submit your admission application and all required documents to the Office of Admissions and Enrollment Services by the scholarship deadline. Your application for admission also serves as your scholarship application.
