Action Items:

1. Dr. Frederickson, on behalf of subcommittee one, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of Computer Science / **BS in Data Science** for **new degree program by reconfiguration** of the existing degree program. Dr. Charlton seconded the motion. Motion passed, all in favor.
2. Dr. Frederickson, on behalf of subcommittee one, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of Computer Science / Cybersecurity to **add required course CSCI 4305 Linux/UNIX Systems and remove required course CSCI 3380** Computer Architecture from the Cybersecurity program. Dr. Downey seconded the motion. Motion passed, all in favor.
3. Dr. Jordan, on behalf of subcommittee two, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of Computer Science for new course **CSCI 2310 Introduction to Data Science**. Dr. Downey seconded the motion. Discussion followed concerning who will teach the class. Dr. Celebi indicated that the department has enough faculty to teach the class even though a visiting instructor is listed in the proposal. Motion passed, all in favor.
4. Dr. Jordan, on behalf of subcommittee two, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of Computer Science / Cybersecurity for new course **CSEC 4330 Software Security**. Dr. Powers seconded the motion. Motion passed, all in favor.
5. Dr. Jordan, on behalf of subcommittee two, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of History for new course **HIST 4339 History of Science in America**. Dr. Powers seconded the motion. Motion passed, all in favor.

6. Dr. Case, on behalf of subcommittee three, made a motion to recommend approval of three proposals from the Department of Art and Design for new courses **ART 3355 3D Animation**, **ART 3356 Time-Based Media** and **ART 3363 History of Graphic Design**. Dr. Kim seconded the motion. Motion passed, all in favor.

1. From Art and Design / BA and BFA / Fine Art and Studio Art: to convert **ART 3363** to hybrid delivery.
2. From LLLC / Linguistics BA: to convert **LING 2320** to online delivery.
3. From Art and Design: add **ART 3363** History of Graphic Design to the list of elective courses.
4. From Computer Science / Cybersecurity: explicitly **require PSCI 1330** and **PSCI 2300** in the Management of Cybersecurity and Cyberphysical Security
