Undergraduate Council  
December 2, 2021

The Undergraduate Council met in person and via video conference in Wingo Hall 315.

Dr. Boniecki called the meeting to order at 1:40 pm

Action Items:

1. Dr. Charlton, on behalf of subcommittee one, made a motion to recommend approval of three proposals from the Department of History:
  - a) from Asian Studies/Asian Studies Minor to remove courses ENGL 2320 and HIST 4396 and to add elective courses ENGL 4325, ENGL 4383, HIST 4341, HIST 4395, JAPN 2320, PHIL 1330 and RELG 1320.
  - b.) to change the level and course number for two courses: HIST 4381 to HIST 3383 and HIST 4383 to HIST 3384
  - c.) from African and African American Studies to add courses FREN 3315 and FREN 4396 into the AAAS major and minor programs as electives.Dr. Frederickson seconded the motion. Motion passed, all in favor.
2. Dr. Powers, on behalf of subcommittee two, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of Accounting to change ACCT 4390 to a variable credit course ACCT 4V90 (1-3 variable credit hours) and to update the bulletin language. Dr. Wu seconded the motion. Motion passed, all in favor.
3. Dr. Powers, on behalf of subcommittee two, made a motion to recommend approval of two proposals from the School of Nursing to change the course number and level for NURS 3304 to NURS 3408 and NURS 4335 to NURS 4235. Dr. Frederickson seconded the motion. Motion passed, all in favor.
4. Mr. Johnson, on behalf of subcommittee three, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of Nutrition and Family Sciences/BS in Nutrition Sciences to remove required course FACS 3173 from the major and to reduce the total credit hours from 44 to 43. Dr. Snyder seconded the motion. Motion passed, all in favor.
5. Mr. Johnson, on behalf of subcommittee three, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of Health Sciences – Addiction Studies to change numbers and/or

levels for courses: HSC 2310 to HSC 3311, HSC 2320 to HSC 3321, HSC 2330 to HSC 3331, HSC 3310 to HSC 4311, HSC 3320 to HSC 4322 and HSC 3330 to HSC 4330. Dr. Gillaspay seconded the motion. Motion passed, all in favor.

Information Items:

1. From the College of Business / General Business Minor: clarify that General Business Degrees are not designed for double majors within the College of Business.
2. From History/Asian Studies Minor: change the course title for HIST 4398 from Politics of Sex in East Asia to Gender and Sexuality in East Asia, remove HIST 4386 and update the bulletin language to reflect concurrent action items.
3. From Nutrition and Family Science/BS in Family and Consumer Sciences: add courses FACS 2341 and FACS 2351 to the list of major electives.
4. From Nutrition and Family Sciences/BS in Nutrition Science, BS in Community Nutrition, BS in Dietetics: substitute USCH 3320 for NUTR 4301 in the major requirements.
5. From Nutrition and Family Sciences/BS in Dietetics; BS in Family & Consumer Sciences; BS in Nutrition Science; BS in Community Nutrition, Minor in Family & Consumer Sciences: change title for NUTR 4301 from Research in Family and Consumer Sciences/Nutrition to Research in Nutrition & Family Sciences and update bulletin description.
6. From Nutrition & Family Sciences/BS in Dietetics: remove course prerequisite of BIOL 2405 and add BIOL 3406 to NUTR 4325; and update bulletin language to reflect changes in the registration restrictions for NUTR 4325, NUTR 4335, NUTR 4351 and NUTR 4374.
7. From Political Science: change title for course PSCI 4393 from Experiential Learning in International Studies to Experiential Learning in International Studies or Political Science and update bulletin language.
8. From Political Science: change title for course PSCI 4394 from Research in International Studies to Research in International Studies or Political Science and update bulletin language.
