November 3, 2022

The Undergraduate Council met in Wingo Hall 315 and via video conference.

Dr. Boniecki called the meeting to order at 1:40 pm

Action Items:

1. Dr. Frederickson, on behalf of subcommittee one, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of Nutrition and Family Sciences/BSE in FCS; BS in Family and Consumer Sciences / Minor in FCS for new course **FACS 3302 Housing and Interior Design for Family and Consumer Sciences**. Dr. Bernard Chen seconded the motion. Motion passed, all in favor.
2. Dr. Frederickson, on behalf of subcommittee one, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of Nutrition and Family Sciences / BSE in FCS to remove IDSN 1390 and IDSN 3300 from the major requirements and to **add FACS 3302 and FACS 4317 to the major requirements**. Ms. Van Asche seconded the motion. Motion passed all in favor.
3. Dr. Frederickson, on behalf of subcommittee one, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of Nutrition and Family Sciences / BS in Dietetics to **remove department-specific admissions requirements**. Ms. Van Asche seconded the motion. Motion passed, all in favor.
4. Dr. Frederickson, on behalf of subcommittee one, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of Nutrition and Family Sciences / BS in FCS to **increase major electives from 15 hours to 21 hours** and to **increase the total credit hour requirements from 42 to 48**. Ms. Van Asche seconded the motion. Motion passed, all in favor.
5. Dr. B. Chen, on behalf of subcommittee two, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of Art and Design / Art History to **add existing course ART 3363 (History of Graphic Design) to the UCA Core** for Diversity and to update UBulletin course descriptions for ART 3385 and ART 3395. Ms. Van Asche seconded the motion. Motion passed, all in favor.

6. Dr. B. Chen, on behalf of subcommittee two, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of Art and Design / Art History to **add existing course ART 3385 (Art of India) to the UCA Core** for Diversity. Ms. Van Asche seconded the motion. Motion passed, all in favor.
7. Dr. B. Chen, on behalf of subcommittee two, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of Philosophy and Religion / Religious Studies to **add existing course RELG 3340 (Religion, Science and Technology) to the UCA Core** for Diversity and Responsible Living. Ms. Van Asche seconded the motion. Motion passed, all in favor.
8. Dr. A. Chen, on behalf of subcommittee three, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of Computer Information Systems and Analytics / BS in Cybersecurity to remove the upper division CISA elective requirement and to **add technology requirement CSCI 4305 Linux/Unix Systems**. Ms. Van Asche seconded the motion. Motion passed, all in favor.
9. Dr. A. Chen, on behalf of subcommittee three, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of History for new course **HIST 4356 Nets, Reels, Bows, and Bullets: The History of Hunting, Fishing, and Conservation**. Ms. Van Asche seconded the motion. Motion passed, all in favor.
10. Dr. A. Chen, on behalf of subcommittee three, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of History for new course **HIST 4317 Age of Wonders: The Natural versus the Supernatural World**. Ms. Van Asche seconded the motion. Motion passed, all in favor.
11. Dr. A. Chen, on behalf of subcommittee three, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of History for new course **HIST 3368 Tools of Warfare: A Study of Global Military Technologies**. Ms. Van Asche seconded the motion. Motion passed, all in favor.
12. Dr. A. Chen, on behalf of subcommittee three, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the School of Communication to **add existing course COMM 3310 (Advanced Public Speaking) to the UCA Core** for Inquiry. Ms. Van Asche seconded the motion. Motion passed all in favor.

Information Items:

1. From Nutrition and Family Sciences / BS in Family and Consumer Sciences / Minor in FCS: add **FACS 3302** to the list of major electives.
2. From Nutrition and Family Sciences / BS in FCS: **add FACS 3311** as a pre-requisite option for FACS 4340.

3. From Nutrition and Family Sciences / BSE in FCS / BS in Family and Consumer Sciences / BS in Nutrition Sciences / BS in Community Nutrition / BS in Dietetics / Minor in FCS: **remove course prerequisite** “limited to students with course in degree plan” from the following courses: FACS 2341, FACS 2351, FACS 3311, FACS 3318, FACS 3372, FACS 3356, NUTR 1300, and NUTR 3370.
4. From Nutrition and Family Sciences / BSE in FCS / BS in FCS: **add prerequisite** “or BS in FCS Major” to FACS 4355 and edit course description.
5. From Nutrition and Family Sciences / BS in Family and Consumer Sciences: **convert existing program to online** delivery.
