

MINUTES
Undergraduate Council
February 2, 2023

The Undergraduate Council met in Wingo Hall 315 and via video conference.

The meeting was called to order at 1:40 p.m.

Action Items:

1. Dr. Johnston, on behalf of subcommittee one, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of Music for new course **MUS 2000 Sophomore Review**. Dr. Frederickson seconded. Motion passed, all in favor.
2. Dr. Johnston, on behalf of subcommittee one, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of Music to add new course **MUS 2000** as a required course to all undergraduate music majors. Dr. Filer seconded. Motion passed, all in favor.
3. Dr. Johnston, on behalf of subcommittee one, made a motion to recommend approval of four proposals from the Department of Music for new courses **MUS 2250 Harmony III**, **MUS 2251 Ear Training III**, **MUS 2252 Harmony IV** and **MUS 2253 Ear Training IV**. Dr. Snyder seconded. Motion passed, all in favor.
4. Dr. Johnston, on behalf of subcommittee one, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of Music to remove courses MUS 2430 and MUS 2431 and to add new courses MUS 2250, MUS 2251, MUS 2252 and MUS 2253 to the list of requirements for all undergraduate music majors. Dr. Filer seconded. Motion passed, all in favor.
5. Dr. Johnston, on behalf of subcommittee one, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of Music to remove the Music UDQA policy and implement a minimum "C" grade policy to all courses fulfilling major requirements. Dr. Charlton seconded. Discussion followed. Motion passed, all in favor.
6. Dr. Chen, on behalf of subcommittee two, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of Art and Design for new **course ART 3326 Advanced Drawing Topics**. Dr. Powers seconded. Motion passed, all in favor.

7. Dr. Chen, on behalf of subcommittee two, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of Art and Design for new program emphasis "**Bachelor of Fine Arts with an emphasis in Drawing and Illustration**". Dr. Perry seconded. Motion passed, all in favor.
8. Dr. Chen, on behalf of subcommittee two, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of Biology and Environmental Science for new course **BIOL 4443 Freshwater Ecology**. Dr. Perry seconded. Motion passed, all in favor.
9. Dr. Chen, on behalf of subcommittee two, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of Computer Information Systems and Analytics / General Business to disallow CISA 2330 Business Statistics as an elective in the General Business minor. Dr. Perry seconded. Motion passed, all in favor.
10. Dr. Chen, on behalf of subcommittee two, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of Exercise and Sport Science to add course prerequisite PHYS 1441 to EXSS 3382 Biomechanics. Dr. Perry seconded. Motion passed, all in favor.

Dr. Chen, on behalf of subcommittee two, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of Exercise and Sport Science / BS in Exercise Science to codify a two-course anatomy and physiology sequence as a requirement replacing the old BS Special Degree Requirement. Dr. Perry seconded. Motion passed, all in favor.
12. Dr. Chen, on behalf of subcommittee two, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the School of Nursing / Undergraduate pre-nursing BSN Elective for new course **NURS 2200 Introduction to the Nursing Profession**. Dr. Filer seconded. Motion passed, all in favor.
13. Dr. Chen, on behalf of subcommittee two, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of Psychology and Counseling for new course **PSYC 4302 Psychology Apprenticeship II**. Dr. Perry seconded the motion. Motion passed, all in favor.
14. Dr. Chen on behalf of subcommittee two, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of Psychology and Counseling: (a.) to increase the total credit hour requirements from 36 to 45 (b.) to add/ remove elective courses or change courses from a requirement to an elective in the major/minor (c.) to change level and/or credit value of courses (d.) and to include a certificate of 14 credit hours or more as an alternative to a minor or second major. Dr. Powers seconded. Discussion followed. Motion passed, one abstention, 14 in favor.
15. Dr. Price, on behalf of subcommittee three, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of Economics, Finance, Insurance and Risk Management for

new emphasis program “**B.S. in Economics with a Pre-Law Emphasis**”. Dr. Snyder seconded. Motion passed, all in favor.

16. Dr. Price, on behalf of subcommittee three, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of Economics, Finance, Insurance and Risk Management for new course **ECON 3320 Law and Economics**. Dr. Snyder seconded. Motion passed, all in favor.
17. Dr. Price, on behalf of subcommittee three, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of Film, Theatre, and Creative Writing / Creative Writing Program to modify the BA language requirement from 3 credits of a 2000-level foreign language course to 6 credit hours of language as per the outlined provisions. Dr. Snyder seconded. Motion passed, all in favor.
18. Dr. Price, on behalf of subcommittee three, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of Film, Theatre, and Creative Writing for new course **FILM 4375 Experimental Film Production**. Dr. Gillaspay seconded. Motion passed, all in favor.

Dr. Perry seconded. Motion passed, all in favor.

Dr. Price, on behalf of subcommittee three, made a motion to recommend approval of a proposal from the Department of Health Sciences / Addiction Studies: (a.) to change HSC 4321 from a Related course requirement to a Core course requirement in both the Prevention and Treatment tracks and to change the credit hour requirement in both the Core courses (to 15) and Related Courses (to 6) for both tracks (b.) to change Undergraduate Bulletin wording concerning HLTH 2320 (c.) to remove BIOL 2405 as a required course (d.) and to add HSC 4300 Behavioral Addictions as a required course to the Treatment track. Dr. Snyder seconded. Motion passed, all in favor.
