2. Action Items

The proposed language and roles for the position will continue to be discussed through the semester and we will move to implement the new position in Spring 2025.

4. Provost Updates

- a. Salary Study Timeline: Members received an update regarding the salary study timeline. Institutional Research will reach out to meet with members regarding data for their units.
- b. Strategic Planning Update: Members received a strategic planning update. Phase one of planning will be completed at the end of this semester. Phase two will take place in spring 2025. Phase three will begin in summer 2025, and phase four in fall 2025. The final plan will be presented to the Board of Trustees during the December 2025 meeting.
- c. Student Course Materials Access: There will be a small pilot study in spring 2025 with Textbook Brokers. The study will offer students inclusive (course-based) access to textbook materials. Students have the ability to opt-out at the course level with this pilot. Also being considered is equitable access for future semesters, which is a flat rate for students. Both will ensure day-one access to course materials for students.
