*Breadth Requirements:*

**Fine Arts and Humanities:** Students must take six credits of coursework designated Fine Arts (FA) or Humanities (HUM).

**Social Science:** All students are required to take six credits of social science. To complete the LD UCA Core in 38 credit hours, students should take, in addition to the Social Science course taken in the Critical Inquiry category, a Social Science course in either the Diversity or the Responsible Living category.

**First-Year Seminar.** All freshmen must enroll in a first-year seminar (FYS, as designated below) prior to completing 30 credit hours, including transitional courses. All FYS courses meet a Diversity requirement, except ACAD 1300, HONC 1310, and HONP 1300. Students who do not complete an FYS course under Diversity must complete two Diversity courses in the Creative Works and World Cultures category.
