¹ Please refer to teacher education Level I admission requirements during this semester.

² Piano III and IV are degree requirements but many students need to take Piano I and/or Piano II prior to III and IV. Testing for piano placement is done immediately before the beginning of classes in the Fall semester of the first year of study.

³ Students are required to participate in a large instrumental ensemble for at least seven semester (7 credit hours). If a student does not complete all requirements prior to Internship II by the seventh semester, an eight semester of a large ensemble is required. Woodwind, brass, and percussion majors must participate in a university band to fulfill the large ensemble requirement, including marching band each fall semester, excluding the Internship II semester. String majors must participate in orchestra to fulfill the requirement. During the course of the degree program, it is expected that students will take an appropriate mix of small conducted ensembles in addition to the large ensembles, as assigned by the major professor and the advisor.

⁴ Required before taking the PRAXIS Core Test (previously PRAXIS I).

⁵ See appropriate choices, alternatives, or substitutions under “UCA Core” in the *Undergraduate Bulletin*. During the first year, a student must complete a UCA Core course designated as a First-Year Seminar (FYS) in Critical Inquiry, Diversity, or Responsible Living. The student will also need to complete major courses designated as fulfilling the upper-division and capstone requirements of the UCA Core. Upper-Division (UD) UCA Core includes Communication [C], Critical Inquiry[I],

⁶ A music scholarship may require a second ensemble beginning this semester and continuing for the duration of the scholarship. Students should check specific scholarship requirements concerning this.

⁷ Students are encouraged to take the PRAXIS Core Test (previously PRAXIS I) by the end of the freshman year, and must take it by the end of the sophomore year to stay on track for admission to teacher education program by end of the sophomore year. Please refer to teacher education admission requirements.

⁸ Six credits of Instrumental Methods courses are offered. Five credits of these six are required for woodwind, brass, and percussion majors, resulting in a total degree requirement of 124 hours. Four credits are required for string majors and piano majors/instrumental track, resulting in a total degree requirement of 123 hours.

⁹ Student must be admitted into teacher education program (Level I Admission) by the end of this semester in order to register for MUS 3305 the following semester. The UDQA (Upper Division Qualifying Assessment) will be administered near the end of this semester.

¹⁰ This course must be taken after completion of MUS 1230/1231. Student must have also passed the [Ed Tech Competency Exam](#) or equivalent course (e.g., EDUC 1240, CSCI 1300, or MIS 2343) prior to this semester. The competency exam is recommended.

¹¹ MUS 1340 is a prerequisite for MUS 3302 and should be taken in the sophomore year. MUS 1340 fulfills the LD UCA Core requirement in Diversity in Creative Works/Fine Arts.

¹² Students must have passed the UDQA (Upper Division Qualifying Assessment) prior to this semester to take upper division music classes, including 4000 level lessons and ensembles. This applies to any student who enters UCA as a freshman music major in Fall 2014 or later.

¹³ Student must be admitted to the teacher education program (Level I Admission) to enroll in this course.

¹⁴ Students must take the PRAXIS II (Music: Analysis, Concepts & Processes, and Continuing Knowledge) by Spring or September of this calendar year. PRAXIS II grades must be sent to student by conclusion of the fall semester of this calendar year.

¹⁵ Student must take the remaining portion of the PRAXIS II (Principles of Learning & Teaching, 5-9 or 7-12) by this semester.
