² Piano III and IV are degree requirements but many students need to take Piano I and/or II prior to II and IV. Testing for piano placement is done on the first day of class in Harmony I or Ear Training I. Students who have had little of no piano training should start with Piano I, MUS 1131 in the first semester.

³ Woodwind, brass and percussion majors may participate in a university band or orchestra to fulfill the large ensemble requirement. String majors must participate in the orchestra to fulfill the requirement. During the course of the degree program, it is expected that students will take an appropriate mix of small conducted ensembles in addition to the large ensembles, as assigned by the major professor and the advisor.

⁴ A substitution has been approved allowing MUS 1340 for the Fine Arts elective. MUS 1340 is a prerequisite for MUS 3302 or 3303, and should be taken the sophomore year.

⁵ This is a second ensemble, additional to the large ensemble.

⁶ MUS 4204 might also be taken during the fall term. Students should discuss the timing of this course with the applied instructor.

¹ A music scholarship may require a second ensemble beginning this semester and continuing for the duration of the scholarship. Students should check specific scholarship requirements concerning this.
