¹ See admission to teacher education requirements during this semester.

² A music scholarship may require a second ensemble beginning this semester and continuing for the duration of the scholarship. Students should check specific scholarship requirements concerning this.

³ Piano III and IV are degree requirements but many students need to take Piano I and/or II prior to III and IV. Testing for piano placement is done on the first day of class in Harmony I or Ear Training I. Students who have had little or no piano training should start with Piano I, MUS 1131 in the first semester.

⁴ Chorus or other large ensemble, six semesters required. Vocalists must participate in a choir to fulfill the large ensemble requirement. During the course of the degree program, it is expected that students will take an appropriate mix of small conducted ensembles in addition to the large ensembles, as assigned by the major professor and the advisor.

⁵ Required before taking the PRAXIS I (during Fall of the Sophomore year).

⁶ Students are strongly encouraged to take the PRAXIS I by the end of this semester. See admission to teacher education requirements.

⁷ Student must be admitted to teacher education program by the end of this semester to enroll in MUS 3305 for the following semester.

⁸ Must be taken after completion of MUS 1230 and 1231.

⁹ Substitutions have been approved allowing MUS 1340 for the Fine Arts elective and MSIT 3310 (Development and Learning) for one Social Science elective (PSYC 1300). MUS 1340 is a prerequisite for MUS 3302 or 3303, and should be taken the sophomore year.

¹⁰ Students should not take PSYC 1300 at this time.

¹¹ Students should take the PRAXIS II (Music: Analysis, Concepts & Processes, and Cont. Knowledge) by the end of this semester, or by September of this calendar year, at the latest. PRAXIS II passing scores must be received by the conclusion of the Fall semester of this calendar year.

¹² Student must be admitted to the teacher education program to enroll in this course.

¹³ Student should take the remaining portion of the PRAXIS II (Principles of Learning and Teaching, 5-9 or 7-12) before the end of this semester.
