- <sup>1</sup>Courses in the General Education do not necessarily have to be taken in this order. These are merely suggestions. Students may take whichever general education course they choose as long as all requirements are satisfied. This suggested program satisfies all requirements. For appropriate alternatives or substitutions, see “General Education Program” in the *Undergraduate Bulletin*.
- <sup>2</sup>English majors are encouraged to enroll in ENGL 1350: Introduction to Literature to satisfy their General Education Humanities requirement. If students are unable to enroll in a section of 1350, they are encouraged to take ENGL 2370, 2380, or 2390.
- <sup>3</sup>Students should attempt the competency exam before enrolling in EDUC 1240. An overall score of 75% is required to pass.
- <sup>4</sup>Candidates must be admitted to the English Education Program before enrolling in any Upper Division Education course. More information is available at <http://www.uca.edu/divisions/academic/coe/pfs/level1.htm>, from the Program Director, or from Candidate Services and Field Experiences in Mashburn.
- <sup>5</sup>Candidates for licensure are encouraged to take Language and Grammars Studies, either as the language requirement or as an elective. Candidates for licensure shall take no more than one “Language Course” in addition to the one they take to fulfill the Language Course requirement.
- <sup>6</sup>Students with no previous experience with a foreign language may need to enroll in up to six hours of lower-level instruction to prepare for this requirement. These courses are not included in this plan of study. Please note that such need voids the guaranteed Eight-Semester Plan.
- <sup>7</sup>Candidates for licensure are encouraged to take Shakespeare I or II as their “Author” course.
- <sup>8</sup>These courses must be taken concurrently and are offered only during Fall semesters.
