<sup>1</sup> A minor in Health Education is required. A cum gpa of 2.5 or higher is required for admission, retention and completion of the minor. The Arkansas Department of Education requires PRAXIS II Specialty Area exam #00856 – Health and Physical Education Content Knowledge and #0092 – Physical Education Movement Forms Analysis and Design for licensure in Physical Education.

<sup>2</sup> Candidates must meet admission, retention, and exit requirements of the College of Education and the Physical Education Teacher Education programs. Candidates should be familiar with the specific requirements listed in the *UCA Undergraduate Bulletin* and on the College of Education's and Physical Education Teacher Education websites.

<sup>3</sup> WRTG 1310 or HONC 1310 and WRTG 1320 or HONC 1320 must be taken during the first two semesters of enrollment at UCA. A grade of C or better is required.

<sup>4</sup> A grade of C or better is required.

<sup>13</sup> Candidates must have completed thirty (30) hours prior to enrolling in KPED 2300. If a candidate has not taken the PRAXIS I exams (reading, math, and writing), the candidate must take the PRAXIS I exams during enrollment of the KPED 2300. A copy of the entire score report must be submitted to the KPED 2300 instructor prior to the end of the semester of enrollment in KPED 2300 or an X grade will be recorded. To meet this requirement candidates are strongly encouraged to complete the PRAXIS I exams prior to enrollment in KPED 2300 but no later than the first exam administration date of each semester (September or January) of enrollment in KPED 2300.

<sup>14</sup> Candidates will complete the program's required fitness test during enrollment in KPED 1125 & 1135. Passing scores in all areas (i.e., cardio-respiratory fitness, muscular strength and endurance, body composition and flexibility) is required for admission to the program.

<sup>15</sup> Candidates must enroll in KPED 2340 and KPED 3330 concurrently.

<sup>16</sup> Candidates must enroll in KPED 4690 and KPED 4691 concurrently. Candidates are enrolled in internships that require a minimum commitment from 8:00am through 4:00pm Monday through Friday.

<sup>17</sup> Candidates enrolled in KPED 4380 are required a minimum commitment from 12:00pm through 5:00pm Monday through Friday.
