¹ The program requires 45 hours of art (39 credit hours in art history and 6 credit hours in studio), 44 hours of general education credit (the fine arts requirement is not required for art majors - completion of the major fulfills the requirement), 3 hours of foreign language at the 2000 level, and a minor. Art courses must follow a prerequisite structure. To fulfill the minimum required 120 hours needed for the degree, students may use 6 hours of foreign language prerequisites, if needed, and minor or elective courses, or a combination of these. See additional information about minors and foreign language prerequisites below.

² ART 4302 requires a written proposal submitted for departmental approval the semester prior to enrollment.

³ Students with no previous experience with a foreign language may need to enroll in up to six hours of lower-level instruction to prepare for this requirement. Students with prior experience in a foreign language should contact the Department of World Languages, Literatures, and Cultures to take the departmental placement test before enrolling in their first course. If a student has not completed the six hours of lower-level instruction by this time, please note that the Eight-Semester Plan will be voided.

⁴ This Program Completion Plan requires a minor field of study. Please note – studio art may not serve as a minor for this degree. Depending on the program, minor requirements range from 18 to 27 credit hours. The student will need to adjust the number of general elective or minor elective credit hours in this PCP as needed. Example #1: If a student needs to take both foreign language prerequisites, and selects a minor requiring 18 hours, then the student will need to take an additional 4 hours of elective credit to complete the required minimum 120 hours. Example #2: If a student does not need to take both foreign language prerequisites and selects a minor requiring 27 hours, then the student will need to take an additional 1 hour of elective credit to complete 120 hours. Depending on a student's choice of courses to satisfy special degree and minor requirements, the total number of credit hours taken may exceed the total number of credit hours required to complete the degree plan.
