³ Program admission is required before a student can take SPTH courses at the 3000 and 4000 levels. Applications to the program are accepted after 60 credit hours are completed. Admission is competitive and selective. Admission into the program requires a 2.70 minimum cumulative GPA and a 3.0 (at least B in all SLP classes) minimum major GPA.

⁴ This degree plan assumes six (6) hours of math to satisfy the B.S. special degree requirements. Depending on a student's choice of special degree requirement classes, the total number of credit hours taken may exceed the total number of credit hours required to complete the degree program.
