ⁱ See admission to teacher education requirements during this semester.

ⁱⁱ A music scholarship may require a second ensemble beginning this semester and continuing for the duration of the scholarship. Students should check specific scholarship requirements concerning this.

ⁱⁱⁱ Piano III and IV are degree requirements but many students need to take Piano I and/or II prior to III and IV. Testing for piano placement is done on the first day of class in Harmony I or Ear Training I. Students who have had little or no piano training should start with Piano I, MUS 1131 in the first semester.

^{iv} Woodwind, brass and percussion majors must participate in a university band each semester, including 3 or more semesters of marching band. String majors must participate in the university orchestra a minimum of six semesters.

^v Required before taking the PRAXIS I (during Fall of the Sophomore year).

^{vi} Students are encouraged to take the PRAXIS I by end of freshman year, but must take it by end of sophomore year to stay on track for admission to teacher ed. program by end of sophomore year. See admission to teacher education requirements.

^{vii} Student must be admitted to teacher education program by the end of this semester to enroll in MUS 3305 for the following semester.

^{viii} 6 hours of Instrumental Methods courses are offered; 5 hours out of the 6 are required for woodwind, brass and percussion majors. 4 hours are required for string majors and piano majors/instrumental track. See Undergraduate Bulletin for details.

^{ix} Substitutions have been approved allowing MUS 1340 for the Fine Arts elective and MSIT 3310 (Development and Learning) for one Social Science elective (PSYC 1300). MUS 1340 is a prerequisite for MUS 3302 or 3303, and must be taken the sophomore year due to scheduling conflicts with MUS 1230.

^x If student prefers to take PSYC 1300 at this time, an additional social science gen. ed. must be taken. It is suggested that students NOT take PSYC 1300 unless they have an interest in psychology or are minoring in psychology.

^{xi} Must be taken after completion of MUS 1230 and 1231. Must have passed EDUC 1240 or the Ed. Tech proficiency exam prior to this semester or took MUS 2210 with Dr. Rose by Spring 2010.

^{xii} Students must take the PRAXIS II (Music: Analysis, Concepts & Processes, and Cont. Knowledge) by Spring or September of this calendar year. PRAXIS II grades must be sent to student by the conclusion of the Fall semester of this calendar year.

^{xiii} Student must be admitted to the teacher education program to enroll in this course.

^{xiv} Student must take the remaining portion of the PRAXIS II (Principles of Learning and Teaching, 5-9 or 7-12) by this semester.
