ⁱⁱⁱ BM in Education pianists on the vocal track will substitute 2 semesters of voice, MUSA 21xx; pianist on the instrumental track will substitute 2 hours of another instrument.

^{iv} Chorus or other large ensemble, six semesters required. Piano majors may substitute up to three semesters of accompanying (MUS 4140) for the large ensemble requirement. During the course of the degree program, it is expected that students will take an appropriate mix of small conducted ensembles in addition to the large ensembles, as assigned by the major professor and the advisor.

^v Required before taking the PRAXIS I (during Fall of the Sophomore year).

^{vi} Students must take the PRAXIS I by the end of this semester. See admission to teacher education requirements. Students must also take the Ed Tech Competency Exam before the fall sophomore semester begins. Students who don't pass the exam must take EDUC 1240 prior to taking MUS 2211. MUS 2211 is only taught in the spring and freshman theory is a prerequisite.

^{vii} Student must be admitted to teacher education program by the end of this semester to enroll in MUS 3305 for the following semester.

^{viii} Substitutions have been approved allowing MUS 1340 for the Fine Arts elective and MSIT 3310 (Development and Learning) for one Social Science elective (PSYC 1300). MUS 1340 is a prerequisite for MUS 3302 or 3303, and must be taken the sophomore year due to scheduling conflicts with MUS 1230.

^{ix} Students should not take PSYC 1300 at this time.

^x Must be taken after completion of MUS 1230 and 1231. Students must take the Ed Tech Competency Exam before the fall sophomore semester begins. Students who don't pass the exam must take EDUC 1240 prior to taking MUS 2211. MUS 2211 is only taught in the spring and freshman theory is a prerequisite.

^{xi} Students must take the PRAXIS II (Music: Analysis, Concepts & Processes, and Cont. Knowledge) by Spring or September of this calendar year. PRAXIS II grades must be sent to student by the conclusion of the Fall semester of this calendar year.

^{xii} Student must be admitted to the teacher education program to enroll in this course.

^{xiii} Student must take the remaining portion of the PRAXIS II (Principles of Learning and Teaching, 5-9 or 7-12) by this semester.
