<sup>1</sup> The program requires 45 hours of art (39 credit hours in art history and 6 credit hours in studio), 35 hours of UCA Core courses (the fine arts requirement is not required for art majors - completion of the major fulfills the requirement), 3 hours of foreign language at the 2000 level, and a minor. Art courses must follow a prerequisite structure. To fulfill the minimum required 120 hours needed for the degree, students may use 6 hours of foreign language prerequisites, if needed, and minor or elective courses, or a combination of these. See additional information about minors and foreign language prerequisites below.

In order to complete the state-mandated minimum number of hours for core requirements in general education, art majors are required to complete a Humanities course in the Diversity in Creative Works category and a Humanities course in either the Responsible Living category or the Diversity in World Cultures category.

<sup>2</sup> See appropriate choices, alternatives, or substitutions under “UCA Core” in the Undergraduate Bulletin. During the first year, a student must complete a UCA Core course designated as a First-Year Seminar (FYS) in Critical Inquiry, Diversity, or Responsible Living. The student will also need to complete major, minor, or general elective courses designated as fulfilling the upper-division and capstone requirements of the UCA Core.

<sup>3</sup> Students with no previous experience with a foreign language may need to enroll in up to six hours of lower-level instruction to prepare for the 2000 level course that is required for the degree (Fall, Year 3). Students with prior experience in a foreign language should contact the Department of World Languages, Literatures, and Cultures to take the departmental placement test before enrolling in their first course.

The Academic Advising Center and the Department of World Languages, Literatures, and Cultures recommend that students complete the foreign language requirement as early as possible in their program in order to not lose fluency gained in high school.

<sup>4</sup> This Program Completion Plan (PCP) includes 24 hours in the Minor field of study. Minor requirements range from 15 to 31 credit hours. Depending on the minor selected and courses needed to meet the foreign language requirement, the student will need to adjust the number of general elective and minor elective credit hours in this PCP. Please note: art studio may not serve as a minor for this degree.

<sup>5</sup> ART 4302 requires a written proposal submitted for departmental approval the semester prior to enrollment.
