Notes

¹ This Program Completion Plan includes 18 credits in a minor field of study. Minor requirements range from 15-31 credit hours. Students will need to adapt the number of general elective and minor elective credit hours in this plan as needed, depending upon the chosen minor. Given a student's choice of minor and special degree requirements, the total number of credit hours taken may exceed the total number of credit hours required to complete the degree.

² Piano III and IV are degree requirements but many students need to take Piano I and/or Piano II prior to III and IV. Testing for piano placement is done immediately before the beginning of classes in the Fall semester of the first year of study.

³ During the course of the degree program, it is expected that students will take an appropriate mix of small conducted ensembles in addition to the required large ensemble each semester, as assigned by the major professor and the advisor.

⁴ Required before taking the PRAXIS I exam. This exam is recommended if the student anticipates teaching in public schools in the future.

⁵ See appropriate choices, alternatives, or substitutions under "UCA Core" in the *Undergraduate Bulletin*. During the first year, a student must complete a UCA Core course designated as a First-Year Seminar (FYS) in Critical Inquiry, Diversity, or Responsible Living. The student will also need to complete major, minor, or general elective courses designated as fulfilling the upper-division and capstone requirements of the UCA Core.

⁶ A music scholarship may require a second ensemble beginning this semester and continuing for the duration of the scholarship. Students should check specific scholarship requirements concerning this.

⁷ MUS 1340 is a prerequisite for MUS 3302 and should be taken in the sophomore year. MUS 1340 has been approved as a course for UCA Core Fine Arts credit in Diversity in Creative Works.

⁸ Students with no previous experience with a foreign language may need to enroll in up to six hours of lower-level instruction to prepare for this requirement. These courses are not included in this plan of study.
