**Notes**

<sup>1</sup> Piano III and IV are degree requirements but many students need to take Piano I and/or Piano II prior to III and IV. Testing for piano placement is done immediately before the beginning of classes in the Fall semester of the first year of study.

<sup>2</sup> Eight semester hours of a large choral ensemble are required. MUSE 2110 and 4110 require an audition. MUSE 2111 and 4111 do not require an audition. During the course of the degree program, it is expected that students will take an appropriate mix of small conducted ensembles in addition to the large ensembles, as assigned by the major professor and the advisor.

<sup>3</sup> See appropriate choices, alternatives, or substitutions under "UCA Core" in the *Undergraduate Bulletin*. During the first year, a student must complete a UCA Core course designated as a First-Year Seminar (FYS) in Critical Inquiry, Diversity, or Responsible Living. The student will also need to complete major or general elective courses designated as fulfilling the upper-division and capstone requirements of the UCA Core.

<sup>4</sup> Students not already accepted into the performance track should apply for admission during this semester. Students must pass a performance track audition jury before being admitted into the performance track. A 'Performance Track Application' form must be completed and approved by all area faculty members at the time of the jury.

<sup>5</sup> A music scholarship may require a second ensemble beginning this semester and continuing for the duration of the scholarship. Students should check specific scholarship requirements concerning this.

<sup>6</sup> MUS 1340 is also a prerequisite for MUS 3302 and should be taken in the sophomore year. MUS 1340 has been approved as a course for UCA Core Fine Arts credit in Diversity in Creative Works.

<sup>7</sup> Vocal majors are required to take one year of a foreign language. French or German is recommended as a significant part of vocal repertoire exists in these languages. The requirement is waived for students who have taken a placement exam from the UCA World Languages Department or have AP/CLEP scores to demonstrate they would test into a 2000 level or higher class.

<sup>8</sup> In addition to the Senior Recital for credit, a non-credit Junior Recital is also required.
