- Written Communication Skills to prepare reports on finance, internal controls, and audit results.
- **Problem-Solving Skills** to turn financial data into information that can help solve problems.
- Analytical Thinking to apply accounting rules to new situations.
- Ethical Decision Making to decide how reports are used or interpreted.
