Students who have already earned credit for another 1000-level MATH course (i.e., concurrent credit, CLEP, AP, transfer, etc.) may substitute that course for MATH 1360. However, a student who has not completed a 1000-level MATH course must enroll in MATH 1360.

In addition to lower-division (LD) UCA Core requirements—including a First-Year Seminar—the student will also need to complete major, minor, or general elective courses designated as fulfilling the upper-division and capstone requirements of the UCA Core. <sup>4</sup> PRLS 2305 fulfills both a requirement in the BS in Communication and a Social Science requirement in the LD UCA Core.

<sup>5</sup> Students have two options for completing the Bachelor of Science (BS) Course Related Requirements:

<u>Option 1</u>: In addition to the Lower-Core requirements in mathematics and science, the first option for the Bachelor of Science degree in Communication requires the completion of two courses in mathematics (MATH) or two courses in laboratory science (e.g., BIOL, CHEM, etc.) or any combination of the two (e.g., one MATH and one BIOL).

<u>Option 2</u>: The second option requires the completion of one of the following courses in statistical methods (PSYC 2300 Psychology Statistics, PSCI 2312 Statistical Methods for Political Analysis, or SOC 2321 Social Statistics) <u>and</u> PRLS 3315 Applied Research Methods in Public Relations. Please note that no credit will be awarded in more than one introductory statistics course. The statistics courses listed above are preferred and should be chosen if a student has not completed another introductory statistics course, but a student who has successfully completed another introductory statistics course—at UCA, the
