- <sup>3</sup> All students are required to complete UCA's Music Theory and Ear Training Placement Exams prior to enrolling in MUS 1230 Harmony I and MUS 1231 Ear Training I. Exam scores are used to make an official recommendation whether a student is adequately prepared to enroll in Harmony I and Ear Training I or if MUS 1300 Fundamentals of Music Theory is recommended before a student enrolls in Harmony I and Ear Training I.
- <sup>4</sup> MUS 2133 Piano Class III and MUS 2134 Piano Class IV are degree requirements, but a student may need MUS 1131 Piano Class and/or MUS 1132 Piano Class II prior to MUS 2133 Piano Class III. Piano placement exams occur immediately before the beginning of classes in the fall semester of the first year of study.
- <sup>5</sup> See appropriate choices, alternatives, or substitutions under <u>UCA Core</u> in the *Undergraduate Bulletin*. During the first year, a student must complete an LD UCA Core course designated as a First-Year Seminar (FYS) in Diversity, Critical Inquiry, or Responsible Living. An approved LD UCA Core lab science and an approved LD UCA Core math course should be taken in the first two years if possible.
- <sup>6</sup> Students who previously earned credit for another 1000-level MATH course that fulfills the LD UCA Core Quantitative category requirement may substitute that course for MATH 1360.
- <sup>7</sup> During Year 2, music education majors should begin the UCA Teacher Education Program admission process. Music education majors must be fully admitted to the UCA Teacher Education Program prior to the fifth semester of study in order to graduate within eight semesters.
