

CIVIL ASSET FORFEITURE IN ARKANSAS

Arkansas law enforcement seizes **millions of dollars worth** of property and cash every year



Between 2010–18 nearly **\$59 million** in cash was seized in Arkansas—not counting the value of other property seized.

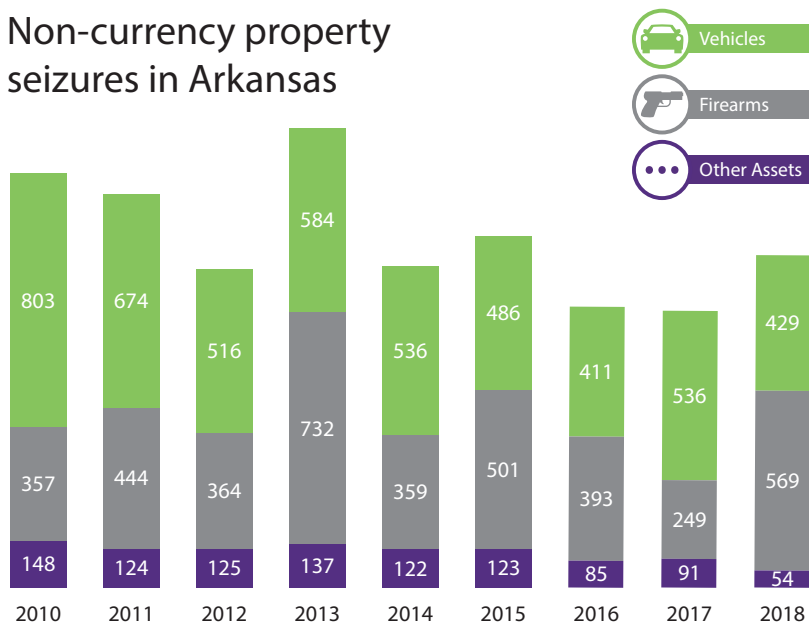


Citizens' property is **guilty** until proven **innocent** under arcane forfeiture laws

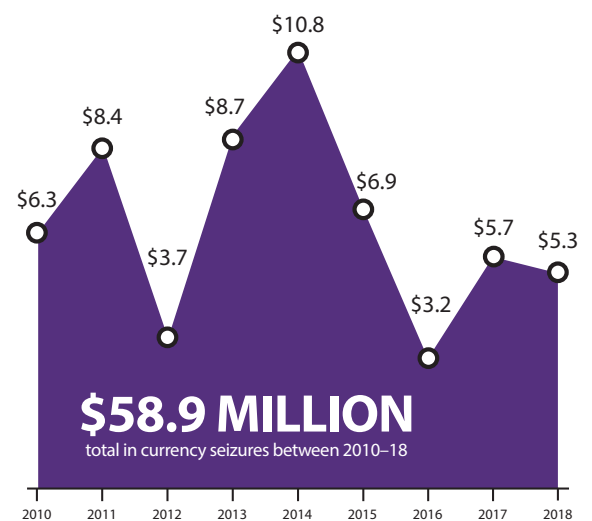


Property seizures are concentrated along Interstate 40, yet **87%** targeted Arkansas residents in 2010–18
