

WHAT IS ALL OF THIS?

DECODING YOUR SCHEDULE

In "Look Up Classes", click on any CRN for more class information such as description, pre-reqs, etc. Course numbers and CRNs are also used to purchase correct textbooks.

Campus codes other than Main or M (Main Campus) means the class is reserved for specific populations.

This shows you what day(s) your class meets. The first example circled shows that this class in this instance the lab portion of the class meets on Tuesdays from 10:00 to 11:50 only. When viewing the schedule the days of the week are abbreviated as *MTWRF*. The second set circled—*TR*--means this class will meet on **both Tuesdays and Thursdays** from 8:00 to 9:15.

Department code used to differentiate between classes. For example, WRTG 1310 --

WRTG is the Department of Writing

1 means this is a freshman level class

3 means it is worth 3 hours credit

10 last two digits differentiates this class from others within the department

Be aware of start dates. Some classes do not start at the beginning of the semester.

This shows you the total number of credit hours you are enrolled in this semester.

REMEMBER: It is always a good idea to print a copy of your schedule the day before classes start, in case room locations and/or instructors have changed.
