Due to the size of the University of Central Arkansas Collection (M99-01), it is advised to use the keystrokes Ctrl + f to activate a search bar for the finding aid page. Within the search bar, researchers may type various search terms to receive highlighted results. No search is perfect, but completing searches on all forms of a noun / subject can capture a more complete list of results within the finding aid. For an example of how to search using Ctrl + f, see the UCA Archives [Researchers' Guide to the Archives](#) found in the [FAQ](#) section of the UCA Archives webpage. **Ctrl + f may be used for all collections, and collection types, regardless of size.**

## Appendix II: A Brief Discussion of Magnetic Media

In the case where cassette tapes, VHS, reel-to-reels, or motion picture film reels are present within the manuscript collection selected for research appointments, these materials may not be available for patrons due to the nature of the mediums. Magnetic mediums require climate controlled storage to stabilize the varying formats until digitization can be completed. Furthermore, the UCA Archives may not currently have the required equipment to complete digitization of the material on the magnetic mediums, or they are currently in a queue for digitization. **Please consult the UCA Archives staff regarding instances of viewing or listening to magnetic media.**

### Types & Accelerants of Degradation (Cassette Tape, VHS, Reel-to-Reel)

- Mold
- Stress damage due to stacking cassettes on top of each other
- Pest damage
- *Sticky Shed Syndrome*—degradation where tapes deposit residue on the playback equipment which can cause damage and affect the sound or video signal layer.<sup>233</sup>
- *Playback & rewind wear*—cassettes often snap and require a repair kit. Once a cassette tape snaps and is repaired, the next playback is typically reserved for digitization purposes to ensure the material recorded is preserved, and therefore accessible.

### Types & Accelerants of Degradation (Motion Picture Film Reels)

- *Vinegar Syndrome*—acetate based film reels which have reached a critical point for preservation emit a sour, vinegar smelling gas. Once the reel hardens, it is immalleable, and the material on the reel cannot be digitized. Reels that have the vinegar smell must be removed from collections with like material to avoid spread of vinegar syndrome to “healthy” reels.<sup>234</sup>
- Heat
- Moisture
- Shrinkage
- *Acid*—storage containers and folders containing acidic components accelerate the rate of degradation

## Appendix XIII: Making Connections Across Collection Types

While this guide focuses on manuscript collections found within the UCA Archives, there are other [source materials](#) that may complement the material found within manuscript collections.

In addition to the Manuscript Collections, the UCA Archives has source material within the [Pamphlet Collection](#) and [Small Manuscript Collection](#). Both collections contain material across multiple disciplines and topics, and the UCA Archives recommends researchers consult these collections in creating a robust bibliography.

Due to the size of the Pamphlet Collection and Small Manuscript Collection, it is advised to use the keystrokes Ctrl + f to activate a search bar for the finding aid page. Within the search bar, researchers may type various search terms to receive highlighted results. No search is perfect, but completing searches on all forms of a noun / subject can capture a more complete list of results within the finding aid. For an example of how to search using Ctrl + f, see the UCA Archives [Researchers' Guide to the Archives](#) found in the [FAQ](#) section of the UCA Archives webpage. **Ctrl + f may be used for all collections, and collection types, regardless of size.**

## Appendix XIV: Final Notes

Throughout the creation of this guide, several instances of changing archival trends and possible biases have been noted. The purpose of this section is to acknowledge such instances and make note for the UCA Archives' Strategic Plan for diversification found within the [FAQ](#) page.

### Naming Conventions within Manuscript Collections

#### A Brief Discussion of Collection Name Components

As researchers browse the UCA Archives manuscript collections, they will encounter the collection name. On the Manuscript Collections landing page, each collection is listed, beginning with M86-xx.

The current iteration of the UCA Archives began in 1986, and the first collections were processed within that same year. Below is an explanation of the components of a manuscript collection name.

*Example: M87-08, Harold Sherman Collection*

- M—denotes the collection is a manuscript collection
- 87—denotes the year the collection was processed, 1987
- 08—denotes that this was the eighth collection processed in 1987

#### Inconsistent Credentials Reflected in Collection Name

Inconsistent credentials are reflected in the name of numerous collections within the UCA Archives. If the qualification is accurately attributed, it is typically found within the finding aid's biographical and contextual introduction.

*In instances where the qualification is listed appropriately in the manuscript collection title, the collection may have been newly created or combined with another resulting in the qualification accurately attributed in the collection name.*

- **Example:** Dr. Greg J.W. Urwin Collection ([M99-10](#)); Cathy Kunzinger Urwin Collection ([M99-11](#)) —both individuals in the collections listed earned doctorates; however, only Greg J.W. Urwin has the qualification listed in the collection name.

## Collection Name Does Not Reflect Collection Material

Some collections bear names which do not reflect the true content of the collection. In these instances, the collections may be renamed in the future to facilitate accessibility.

- **Example:** Annielaura M. Jaggars Collection ([M96-04](#)). This collection contains a wealth of primary source material from Arkansas Poet Laureate Lily Peter. A more accurate collection name could be the Lily Peter Collection (M96-04) with contextual information within the finding aid noting that Annielaura M. Jaggars completed a biography on Lily Peter.
- **Example:** Phi Delta Kappa Collection ([M02-04](#)). While the collection name does accurately depict the material within, the addition of UCA in the title would provide greater accuracy and clarity when searching for collections relevant to the University of Central Arkansas.
- **Example:** Shane C. Dunn Collection ([M02-07](#)). This collection contains material relevant to World War II, specifically that of Franz Ziereis, an overseer of numerous German concentration camps. The collection name could be amended to include “/ World War II” for clarification or changed to include Franz Ziereis.

## Uniting Collections

Researchers browsing through this guide may notice the large University of Central Arkansas subcategory, and question why some of the collections listed are not part of the Official Records of the University of Central Arkansas Collection (M99-01). The UCA Archives recognizes that several collections would be more appropriate within the Official Records of the University of Central Arkansas Collection, and has long-term plans of uniting them for ease of access for researchers and UCA Archives staff.

- **Example:** UCA Press Records Collection ([M97-01](#))
- **Example:** UCA Depression Era Construction Collection ([M97-02](#))
- **Example:** Torreyson Library Collection ([M02-16](#))

## Representation within Manuscript Collections

During the creation of this guide, the author noted that while there are manuscript collections which highlight events and specific communities & studies, for example: gender / women’s history, military history, Civil Rights, BIPOC, the bulk of the manuscript collections is often from the white, male perspective. Throughout the guide, efforts were taken to be as inclusive as possible, collection permitting, and to highlight potential hidden histories. Where there are representation gaps, the UCA Archives’

strategic plan addresses collection representation gaps and steps to increase diversification found within the [FAQ](#) page.

- **Example:** [BIPOC, Historically Underrepresented Individuals & Groups](#), p.10, contains only seven collections total with material of persons of color and/or those of the LGBTQIA+ community.
- **Example:** [Civil Rights](#), p.10-11, contains several collections; however, a little over half are from those associated with opposition to the Civil Rights movement.
- **Example:** [Women's History, Women's Groups & Organizations](#), p.8, consists of several collections; however, few contain material from persons of color, those of the LGBTQIA+ community, or from other historically underrepresented communities.
- **Example:** [Religion & Cemeteries](#), p.38-39, contains collections which are of the Protestant and Catholic faiths; the UCA Archives lacks collections which represent other religions.
- **Example:** [Military History](#), p.11-14, contains numerous manuscript collections; however, the predominant topic is that of World War II. Further analysis concludes that of the collections included in the World War II topic, an overwhelming majority of collections included are from white males who fought.

## Reparative Language & Metadata

As part of the UCA Archives' Strategic Plan, efforts are underway to use current terminology and language that reflects respect and care towards groups and individuals of communities historically underrepresented and have faced institutional, implicit (unconscious), and explicit biases within society.<sup>287</sup>

The purpose of this is to establish, or in instances reestablish, connections with more diverse members of the University of Central Arkansas, Conway, Faulkner County, and Central Arkansas communities, thus having archives which represent and reflect those community stakeholders.

Moreover, connecting with members of these diverse communities allows the UCA Archives to more accurately describe the materials under its stewardship, through the education of cultures and meaningful conversations between said communities and the UCA Archives. This provides opportunities to:

- include the community in the descriptive process and allow the community to contribute unique identifiers, vocabulary, and search terms to the descriptive record(s)
- link collections with those of other institutions, providing a deeper knowledge of these communities while facilitating greater access to primary sources for researchers

Academically, these educational opportunities and meaningful conversations can result in the constructive critique of individual disciplines providing not only scholars, but members of these communities, the space to challenge accepted standards and norms.

The UCA Archives has partnered with French faculty and students, who have challenged the way oral histories are traditionally focused—that of recording generational trauma. Instead, memories of joy provide a slice-of-life insight into diverse cultural communities within the University of Central Arkansas, Conway, Faulkner County, and Central Arkansas communities, thus creating an archive of memory which reflects a population historically overlooked through a different perspective. **See [Oral Histories: The UCA Griotte Project](#) for more information about the work of Dr. K.
