Signed Internship Proposal *

Internship proposal must include the following: 1. A cover sheet signed by you and your UCA faculty mentor 2. A description of what your major responsibilities will be 3. A description of your specific learning objectives, and how this experience will allow you to accomplish them 4. You should include a resume, bio or clarifying description of the artist or organizations professional work and accomplishments. 5. An approximate schedule for completion of minimum number of required hours and include approximate dates for a minimum of two progress checks between the internship mentor and the faculty sponsor.



Example images of Artist/Agency/Organization work *

Include images to familiarize faculty with the work of your internship sponsor. Images must be formatted in the following way: 1. JPEGs only 2. No more than 2000 pixels on a side i.e. max size 2000x2000 3. Images not to exceed 2MB each 4. RGB color only, convert CMYK to RGB 5. Use 85% quality, or 9 if using Photoshop, when saving your files a. JPEG compression is set when an image file is saved. In most applications, a slider from 0-100 is there for choosing quality. In Photoshop, the slider is from 1-12. If a JPEG is opened and manipulated and then just saved, the dialog box probably won't be given and the compression will be set based on the original file. In that case, the image will most-likely be well within the 2MB limit since most JPEGs are compressed. The best practice is to open a photo, resize it, and then "Save As" or "Export" to create a new file. That way the original is not changed and compression options are displayed. 6. Name the images with your last name and first name and a number. Do not use spaces. For example, Lastname_Firstname-01.jpg, Lastname_Firstname-02.jpg 7. Include a text file with a list of your images that includes the JPEG file number, title, media, dimensions, and course (if applicable). Text files may be .txt, .docx, or .pdf. Name your file Lastname_Firstname-00. 8. For videos, upload them to YouTube and copy the URL addresses to the list of images. You can make the videos private if you prefer and put the password in the image list. Make the password simple and something you know you will share with others.
