Hello everyone,

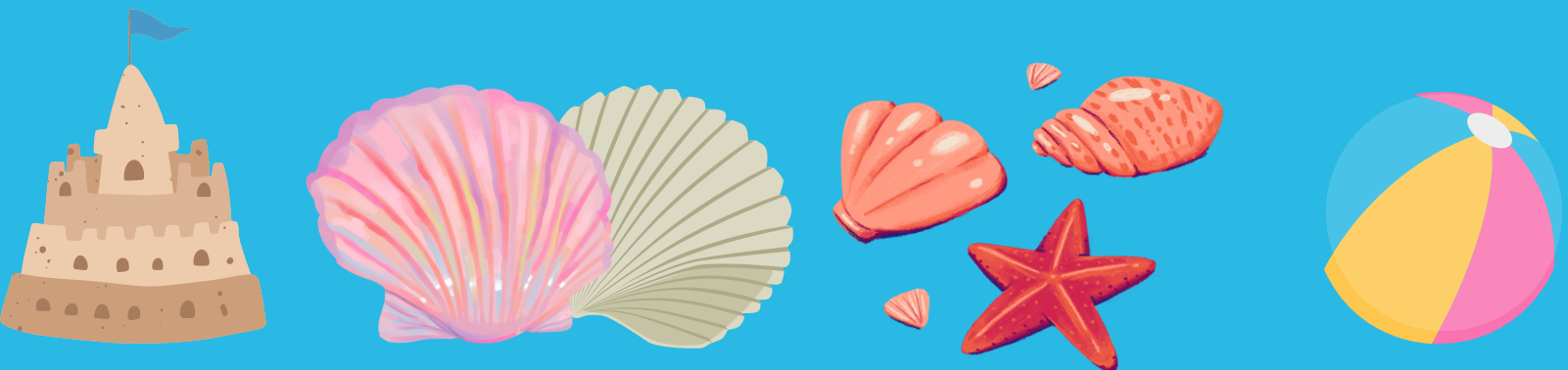
