# CONDITIONS OF APPOINTMENT AS APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Requirements of Professional Growth for Faculty

All faculty members are expected to grow professionally during their time of service at State College of Arkansas.

- 1. Persons with full-time faculty rank who do not possess the doctorate or other terminal degree
  - and are forty years of age or younger will earn at least six hours in a degree program every two years.
  - b. and are over forty years of age will plan with their department head and dean a definite program of professional growth to be approved by the Council of Deans
- 2. Persons with full-time faculty rank who possess the doctorate or other terminal degree will demonstrate consistent professional growth, whether it be post-doctoral study, research, performance, experience outside their regular appointment, or service. This plan should be developed in consultation with the department head and dean.

Part time personnel will demonstrate acceptable professional growth as a basis for their continued association with the college.

Each faculty member is given an opportunity to provide the college a full account of his work in an annual report submitted each spring. (See Exhibit F.)
