

Little Rock, Arkansas.

On this 23rd. day of March, 1923, the Board of Trustees for the State Normal School met, pursuant to adjournment in the office of Hon. A. B. Hill, with the following members present, to-wit: Hon. A. B. Hill, A. L. Hutchins, W. E. Lenon, Joe Frauenthal, L. S. Dunaway, and Joe Ferguson.

The meeting was called to order by Hon. A. B. Hill, Chairman, and the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Hon. Jas. Guy Tucker, Secretary, being absent Joe Ferguson was elected Secretary pro tem.

On motion of A. L. Hutchins, seconded by W. E. Lenon, Mrs. William Little was elected Piano teacher without salary to begin July 1, 1923.

On motion of Mr. Lenon seconded by Mr. Hutchins, R. L. Turner was elected instructor of rural education at a salary of \$2,500.00 per annum beginning Sept., 1, 1923.

On Motion of Mr. Dunaway seconded by Mr. Lenon, Mr. Torreyson was authorized to move fence on north side of property to provide a lane to the athletic field.

On motion of Mr. Hutchins, seconded by Mr. Dunaway, Mr. Hill Chairman, appointed Mr. Dunaway, Joe Frauenthal, and A. L. Hutchins as a committee of three to investigate and make report on the feasibility of building a gymnasium on the Normal School Campus, and secure estimates as to probable cost and tentative plans for same.

Traveling expenses of A. L. Hutchins, L. S. Dunaway and Joe Frauenthal in attending meeting of the board were allowed.

There being no further business, the Board adjourned subject to the call of the Chairman.
