

Conway, Arkansas.  
June 7th. 1923.

On this 7th. day of June, 1923, the Board of Trustees of the Arkansas State Normal School. met pursuant to adjournment, in the office of Mr. B. W. Torreyson, at Conway, Ark. with the following members present, to-wit:  
Hon. A. B. Hill, Joe Frauenthal, W. E. Lenon, A. L. Hitchens, Joe Ferguson, and Jas. Guy Tucker.

The attached report of the gymnasium committee was read and approved.

The following bids for the construction of the gymnasium were opened. Major & Tyler \$4,157.00, W. A. Russell & Co. \$5,130.00. The bid of Major & Tyler was accepted.

All teachers were re-elected with the exception of Mr. Holloway and Miss Nash, resigned. The following increases in salary were approved effective when the finances of the institution justify same.  
Mr. Short from \$160.00 to \$165.00 per mo. Miss Blackmon from \$133.33 to \$137.50, Miss Schichtyl from \$100.00 to \$108.33, Miss Langley from \$100.00 to \$108.33, Joe Shumate from \$60.00 to \$75.00 Mrs. Torreyson increase of \$35.00 per month out of Dormitory fund. O. D. Smith was elected to succeed Mr. Holloway at a salary of \$216.66 per month. Earl R. Higgins as Asst. Historian at a salary of \$1,800.00 per year. Miss Maude Carmical at a salary of \$1,650.00 per year, effective Sept. 1st. 1923.

The Board stated that it would be its policy to employ Arkansas Teachers when possible.

There being no further business the Board adjourned subject to the call of the Chairman.
