An adjourned meeting of the board of Trustees of the Arkansas State Teachers College was held in the office of the State Commissioner of Education in Little Rock, Arkansas at 11 a.m. Friday June 30, 1933. The following members were present and voting: Hirst, Leonard, Compere, Humphreys and Smith.

Motion by Humphreys, seconded by Smith that Chairman Hirst and Secretary Leonard be instructed to sign contracts for the construction and equipping of the new dormitory to be constructed on the campus at Conway.

Motion carried.




