The following members were present and voting: Phipps, Compere, Parker, Purkins, Smith -- absent: Andrews, Page.


The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Upon his recommendation, motion by Smith, seconded by Compere that: the trainees in the Soil Erosion Service be allowed to register for the night classes in Soil Erosion work and Forestry upon the payment of a matriculation fee of \$10.00 instead of the regular matriculation fee of \$15.00.
