The communication was ordered filed.

and coach for the football team.

The sum of \$100 was appropriated to buy athletic equipment for
the foot ball team at the Normal School.

again Monday, October 15th, at eleven o'clock, A. M., for the pur-
pose of discussing with the Governor matters pertaining to the
completion of the new Administration building.
