- IV. Assessment Sub-Committee
  - a. Draft Reports (Appendices A-C) and Motions
  - b. Held quickly recapitulates the sub-committees findings and rationales for those findings.
    - a. WRTG 2325: B. Chen makes the motion to approve, W. Lucas seconds. No discussion. Approved unanimously.
    - b. MCOM 1300: E. Hostetter moves to approve, S. Watson seconds. No discussion. Approved unanimously.
    - c. BUAD 2303: Z. Smith moves to approve, S. Watson seconds. No discussion. Approved unanimously.
    - d. R. Novy asks about the BUAD 2303 proposal. The committee expressed concerns that the course, as a travel seminar, doesn't meet LD Core standards. Is that a concern for any travel seminar? Held notes that the structure of a seminar may make it hard to provide the experience necessary to be an LD Core course, that is, a foundational exposure to those outcomes. W. Lucas notes that it may be possible in diversity since you're immersed in a culture. S. Watson notes that they simply hadn't demonstrated how they did it, but it's possible they could.

a. The sub-committee sent out a survey to all UCA students and is considering options to improve the FYS program. Held notes that he has to verify the process by which changes to the FYS program are made.

  - USCH 1300: Proposal to remove from diversity and add as FYS to LD Core as responsible living goal A. No longer considering switch from HUM to SS.
    (Permitted in spite of the moratorium on LD Core proposals since it was part of the LD Core review process for responsible living.) W. Lucas moves to approve, S. Tucker seconds. No discussion. Approved unanimously.
