

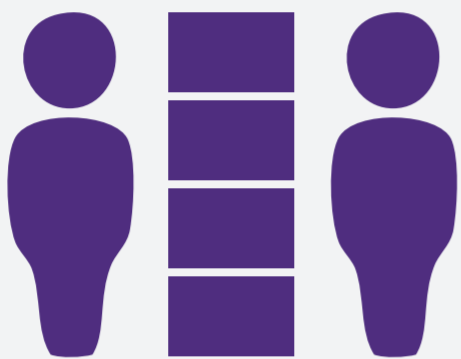
WHAT TO DO IF YOU ARE A

STUDENT

AND

TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

ISOLATE YOURSELF IMMEDIATELY and do not return to campus until designated as *recovered* by the Arkansas Department of Health. If you live in university housing and want to stay on campus, you **MUST** be moved to isolation housing. You cannot remain in your assigned university housing during isolation. If you live off campus, you may quarantine at your residence.

YOU ARE REQUIRED TO EMAIL THE UCA CONTACT TRACING TEAM at covid19@uca.edu to notify them of your positive test results if your test was done off campus. They will then issue an isolation letter and will help determine who your campus-related close contacts are. If your test was ordered through the UCA Student Health Clinic, you will be contacted directly by the Contact Tracing Team and will not need to email them.

THE ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH will also call you a few days after you test positive to complete the contact tracing process and to enroll you in SARA ALERT. You are required by law to cooperate with them to the best of your ability.

NOTIFY YOUR INSTRUCTORS that you have been advised to remain off campus until released by your medical provider. Email your instructor the isolation letter issued by the UCA Contact Tracing Team if the instructor has questions or requests proof of your status.
