

Dear Student,

You have been identified as a recipient of a HEERF emergency grant because you are or were enrolled during the 2022 UCA Spring Session. These funds are provided through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) and are intended to help with educational costs and other financial challenges related to COVID-19.

Every student will be receiving a payment of \$500. However, based on guidance from the Federal Government, students receiving a Pell Grant will receive an additional \$250. Pell Grant eligibility is based on information submitted on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). To confirm your Pell Grant eligibility, review your award information on your myUCA Financial Aid self service portal.

You are not required to complete any documentation to receive these funds. The funds will be direct deposited or mailed by check to you. This will not be applied to any existing account balance. We anticipate you receiving the funds by Friday, February 11. The quickest and safest way to receive your funds is through [Direct Deposit](#). If you prefer a paper check, make sure your mailing address is up-to-date by 5 p.m. on Friday, February 4, 2022. This can be done through your [myUCA](#) account or through the Registrar's office.
