

Albert Garcia is a graduate from Instituto Laredo (Cochabamba) where he was the concertmaster of the Youth Symphony Orchestra for 5 years. He has studied violin with Eduardo Rodríguez Campadello, and later with Dmtry Pokras at the UNC-Córdoba. In 2013, Albert won the international competition *Música Maestro* that is organized by OEI, and was awarded a trip to Panama City to participate in Orquesta Iberoamericana. Other achievements include receiving a scholarship to attend the festival *Música nas Montanhas* in Brazil, and he was the winner of the competition for Best Mendelssohn Performance. Also, he won the audition among 2000 applicants for the Youth Orchestra of the Americas 2017 South America Tour where he performed in the most important theaters in South America including "Teatro cónon" collaborating with artists such as the conductor Miguel Prieto and the cellist Gautier Capuçon. Albert was a member of the program Bolivia Clásica, where he received master classes with Eric Hosler, Ken Aiso, and Leticia Moreno. Albert is currently studying at UCA with Linda Hsu.
