

Zoe Lin, an experienced performer and multi-instrumentalist, has been educating young musicians since 2011, when she began teaching private piano, violin and music theory lessons. Zoe received her Bachelor of Arts degree in Music with a minor in Business Management from the University of Central Arkansas, where she graduated Magna Cum Laude in 2016. After receiving her degree, Zoe became the Music Program Coordinator at Young Musicians of America in Little Rock, Arkansas, teaching private lessons in piano, violin, and music appreciation. In 2017, she received an Early Childhood Teaching Certificate from Age of Montessori in Bozeman, Montana. Later that year, she served as a Lead Teacher in Montessori School of Shanghai in Shanghai, China.

Currently, Zoe is a graduate student pursuing a Graduate Certificate in Piano Performance at the University of Central Arkansas, where she received graduate music scholarships in both piano and violin. Both a talented soloist and sought-after chamber musician, Zoe is preparing for a graduate piano recital in May 2019, and performs regularly in string quartets and in the Conway Symphony Orchestra as a violinist. Fiercely committed to music education and cultivating young talent, Zoe plans to work with Arkansas Teachers Corps. after graduating in May 2019, where she will serve as a music teacher in underprivileged areas of Arkansas.
