Call to Order: Angela Webster called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m.

Agenda Items:

I. Acknowledgement of Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes

The committee reviewed and electronically approved the minutes from October 3, 2016 on October 17, 2016.

II. Sub-Committee Reports

• Data-Assessment:

- Campus Climate Survey:
 - The results have been communicated to the campus
 - Conducted a special meeting with the College of Education based on a special request
 - Looking into hosting the survey for specific sub-groups and add a question to filter data for specific colleges

• Funding:

- Institutional Funding has not changed
- \$15,000 came from President Courtway's discretionary fund previously; President Davis decided to make it a part of the Student Services/Institutional Diversity operating budget; John Fincher is helping to secure sponsorships
- Mr. Williams is working with former board member, Victor Green, to secure potential donors

• Recruitment, Retention, & Development of Diverse Faculty:

- Dr. Angela attended the annual recruitment conference, Compact for Faculty Diversity; she has attended for 4 years now
 - UCA hired an African-American female PhD in Chemistry from this conference
- Institutional Diversity Grant Program
 - Awarded to diverse faculty who want to disseminate their research, any faculty who wants to disseminate their diversity related research, as well as departmental programming and RSO programming
 - Awarded 7 in the 2015-16 academic year; awarded 10 so far this academic year
 - Next due date is April 15, 2017
 - Information is listed on Institutional Diversity website

Diversity and Inclusive Excellence Award:

- This is the 2nd annual award; to be announced during the Employee Service Awards ceremony
- Made changes after the first year
 - Trying to maintain consistency with Faculty Excellence Awards:
 - No ranking; 2 finalists and 1 recipient
 - Added previous recipient to Committee
 - Working toward uniformity in award amount
 - Removed students from faculty/staff award. There is a new student award: Outstanding Diversity Outreach by a Student Award that will be announced at the new Student Involvement Awards ceremony on Wednesday, April 12

Diversity Strategic Planning (Student Success and Retention Council):

- Transitioning to PAWS (Planning and Assessment Web-based System)
 - For assessment reporting purposes
 - All units/departments will have access to it and will be required to use it
 - The outcomes will be preprogramed in the system
 - Will be on-going
- There is currently an overlap in the language of the objectives- we are revising the Diversity Strategic Plan to simplify some language so one initiative can hit multiple categories
- SSRC is finalizing the retention plan for the institution; a lot of these items are tied to diversity
- Nancy Gallavan, John Gilbreath, and Lesley Graybeal have agreed to serve on the sub-committee

Gender Identity on UCA Forms and in Technology Systems:

- Original charge: determine how gender identity could be identified in UCA's current technology systems and whether there would be any costs; met with various leadership and researched other universities
- There are systems that need adjustments to address:
 - Preferred name or nickname, preferred pronoun, application for admission/graduate admission, housing, ID cards, email, directory listings, class rosters, grade rosters, SHC intake forms, counseling center intake, alumni enrollment participation materials and publications
- Current hurdles:
 - There are Banner restrictions which cannot be changed until an upgrade
 - Some forms require legal name such as FASFA and Official Transcript
- Committee looking at what can be accomplished, the timeline and at what cost
- UCA Office of the Registrar has a gender change form available for those who go through the proper legal channels
- Dr. Gallavan made a suggestion to put the gender names in alphabetical order on all forms and in all systems

Gender Neutral Restrooms:

Two New spaces- Doyne Health Science Center and Conway Corporation Center for Sciences- all are listed on the UCA Website and the Diversity website

- Current needs:
 - There is a need for consistency in labeling- graphic with no words
 - Add a lock (vacant or occupied) in the College of Education- Mashburn
 - Need for a gender neutral restroom after hours in the Farris Center area
- There is a Senate bill 774 regarding unlawful use of a restroom of the opposite sex or gender than one's birth certificate; it is currently on hold/being studied for
- Dr. Angela completed a survey for UCA to be designated an LGBT friendly campus through Campus Pride
 - Has a report card up to 5 stars; includes policy inclusion, supporting institutional commitment, campus safety, counseling and health, and recruitment and retention
 - They are interested in not only sexual orientation but also gender identity; our diversity statement does not include gender identity
