Board Comments and Suggestions: The board noted the increase of the percentage of candidates scoring within and above performance ranges over the three year period: 2015-16, 81%; 2016-17, 88%; and 2017-18, 92%. In 2016-17, Multiple Choice III, Managing Organizational Systems and Safety, show 88% of candidates scoring within and above performance ranges, however, in 17-18, 84% of candidates scored within and above performance range. Likewise, Constructed Response IB, Vision and Goals, the candidates in 2016-17 scored 96%, and the 2017-18 scored 84%. The Board suggested we share *the SLS Study Companion: The School Leaders Licensing Assessment Test Preparation* materials with instructors to align the curriculum with the standards specific to their content.

**New Rubrics for Assessments 2 through 7.** The 2017 ELCC SPA review of the SLMA program resulted in a probationary status. The structure of our rubrics for the key assessments was rejected. The rubrics for the key assessments underwent revisions beginning August, 2018.

Board Comments and Suggestions: The Board commented that the revised rubrics gave clearer descriptions of each standard element of the three assessment categories (does not meet expectations, meets expectations, and exceeds expectations). Also, the Board stated the revised rubrics' are a better guide for both the candidates and the assessors work.
