# GATE Practicum Program Feedback

Each advisory board member had previously completed the GATE practicum and was asked to indicate their preferred course structure if applying as a new student. Members selected between an 8-week fall course completed during the school year and a 10-week summer course completed independently with 2–3 students. A slight majority (58%) expressed a preference for the summer option.

## Summary of Perspectives:

- <u>Summer preference due to time flexibility:</u> Several participants shared that summer allowed them to focus on coursework without balancing full-time teaching responsibilities.
- <u>Challenge of student access during summer:</u> Some noted difficulty in locating students to work with over the summer, especially when GT students were unavailable or hard to contact.
- <u>Fall preference for integration with school-year routines:</u> A few participants felt it would be easier to complete practicum requirements during the school year using students already in their classrooms.
- <u>Program flexibility is key:</u> A recurring suggestion was to offer both options to better accommodate different personal schedules and teaching environments.
