Areas of Improvement:

- An area of improvement would be to train them to be focused and in the moment when they are in the classroom. Focus on trying to build relationships with students while in the school.
- Using reading techniques in Math. It's a little more difficult to ensure you're hitting those ideas in a math classroom. Providing a picture of what seamless integration into the content looks like for aspiring math teachers could prevent anxiety or apprehension when trying to address the principle of science of reading in mathematics.
