SUMMARY OF GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

1. A minimum of 120 hours earned from the following areas:
 1. UCA Lower Division Core - 38 hours
 2. Math - 8 hours additional to general education
 3. Major – 30 hours
 4. Minor – 18 hours
 5. Electives to equal 120 hours

A course may not be counted in both the major and the minor.

****Note:**

Major: 7–39 hours may result in the major, depending on the overlap between the general education courses and major courses.

Minor: 18-24 hours

2. No more than 30 hours may be taken in Business. Business courses are considered to be courses with the following prefixes: ACCT, FINA, INSU, MGMT, MIS, MKTG, QMTH.
3. At least a 2.000 Grade Point Average is required overall, in the major, and in the minor
