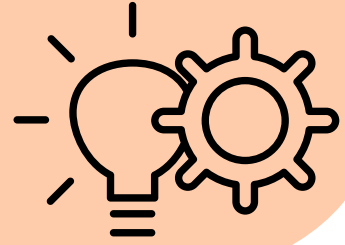
FIELD REQUIREMENTS

ELSE 6348: MULTISENSORY I

You need ONE student in order to administer the PAST assessment.



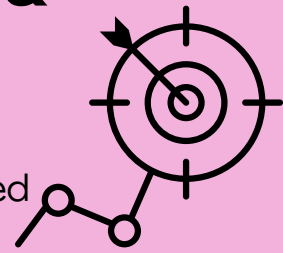
ELSE 6349: MULTISENSORY II

You need ONE student in grades K-5 to complete a handwriting assignment. There are other assignments where a child is recommended, but an adult could be substituted.



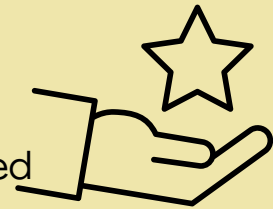
ELSE 6347: LANGUAGE & LITERACY

You need access to ONE student on a K-2 grade level in order to practice giving learned screeners.



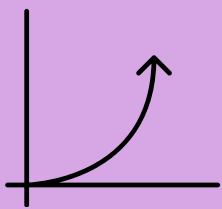
ELSE 6341: EARLY LITERACY

You need access to ONE student on a K-3 grade level in order to practice giving learned screeners.



ELSE 6346: ADOLESCENT LITERACY

You need access to ONE student on a 4-12 grade level in order to practice giving learned screeners.



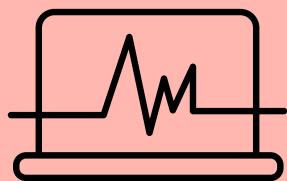
ELSE 6314: IDENTIFYING DYSLEXIA

You need access to ONE student with reading difficulties in order to practice giving a battery of assessments over the course of the semester.



ELSE 6343: PRACTICUM I

You need access to ONE student with reading difficulties in phonological awareness and/or early phonics in grade K-3 to assess and provide 25 hours of intervention.



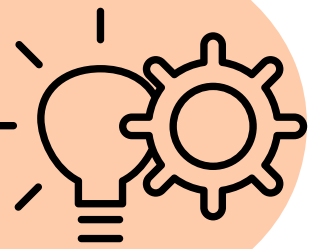
ELSE 6344: PRACTICUM II

You need access to ONE student with reading difficulties at the multisyllabic level of decoding, vocabulary, comprehension, and/or writing in grades 4-12 to assess and provide 25 hours of intervention.



ELSE 6345: LEADERSHIP

You need access to ONE teacher/peer to assess their literacy professional development needs, resulting in submitting a short video of a coaching meeting with an analysis of strengths and weaknesses.



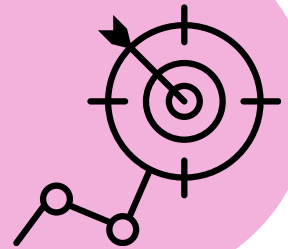
ELSE 6379: DIVERSITY
