- ACADEMIC INTEGRITY METRICS
 - GPAs range increased from 2.77 (2007) to 2.98 (2012) with goals of achieving overall 3.00
 - Federal
 - UCA as a whole – retention rate - 70%

 - Graduation rates for student athletes (50%) continue to exceed entire student body by 10%.

- FINANCE
 - Dr. Teague presented a detailed description of expenditure and revenue for UCA Athletics for the last 10 years. He presented revenues and expenditures compared to other Arkansas universities. Of note was the revenue categories of State Support, Student Fees, and Auxiliary funding. UCA ranks fourth in use of Auxilliary funding and is reducing the amount of state support required.
 - Teague also relayed to the committee the true cost difference between the final year in DII and the FY12 year of DI. The net difference was around \$500,000. Teague encouraged the members to read the report prepared for the Faculty Affairs II Committee, which is posted on-line in Athletics.
