Child Care Center Surveys



Information Gathered:

- O A total of 767 surveys were completed.
- O 95% of faculty/staff surveyed wanted a child care center on campus.
- O 80% of students surveyed wanted a child care center on campus.
- O The majority of students were willing to pay per week was \$95 \$115.
- O The majority of faculty/staff were unsure what amount they would be willing to pay each week. This was followed by those willing to pay \$95-\$115, similar to the students.
- O The majority of faculty/staff would like child care to be from 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. followed by those who would like 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. with an extended care option.
- O The majority of students would like child care to be from 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.; however, it was extremely closely followed by those who would like care from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. with an extended care option.

Common Reason Faculty/Staff Wanted A Child Care Center:

- O Closer to children
- O Draw more non-traditional students to the University
- O Allow for learning experience for students in different programs
- O Fewer missed classes for both faculty and students because they will not have to travel far to deal with problems with their children
- O A draw for faculty/staff to the University
- O Easier pick up/ drop off
- O There would be fewer times when parents would have to bring their children to class

Common Reasons Students Wanted A Child Care Center:

- O Beneficial for non-traditional students
- O Fewer missed classes for students, who are also parents
- O Increase attendance of non-traditional students to the University
- O Good experience for OT, PT, speech, and counseling programs
- O Difficult to find quality care in Conway that does not have a long waiting list
- O Being closer to their children peace of mind

Common Reasons Faculty/Staff Were Against A Child Care Center:

- O Another added cost to the University
- Would represent a capital expenditure that preferentially benefits a subset of the entire UCA community
- O Increasing tuition for everyone just so some have child care would not be fair
- O Illness risk
- O Might be a drain on the UCA budget
- O Not many people on campus indicate a need for this service
- O Start up cost could be used for better University education objectives/goals
- O Not a place for children
- O Safety risk (shootings on campus, school lockdown, etc.)
- O Other options available around Conway for child care

Common Reasons Students Were Against A Child Care Center:

- O More money out of pocket for students
- O Promotes teenage pregnancy
- O Majority of students do not need this service
- O Other options available around Conway for those needing this service
- O Not UCA's job to accommodate for student's or workers purpose is education
- O Location for center would be difficult to place
- O More important things to put the University's money toward
- O Never met anyone with issues regarding child care on campus
- O This is not the right environment for child care
- O Safety liability for the University
