

In regards to the Presidential search committee selection process, the Faculty Senate will review all faculty nominated for the Presidential search policy on 3/8/16, the date of our next regularly scheduled meeting. This will include all faculty names submitted through the Presidential search committee website (<http://uca.edu/presidentialsearch/search-advisory-committee/nominations/>) as well as any names submitted to Faculty Senate President Ben Rowley (browley@uca.edu) by 5 pm on 3/2/16.

This date for nominations to be considered is in effect due to the need to submit meeting materials for the Faculty Senate meeting agenda by 3/3/16.

At the Faculty Senate meeting on 3/8/16, attending Senators will discuss the names put forward and will vote for a total of 5 names to be put forward to the Presidential search committee.

The process at that meeting will include a list of names of faculty nominated (and willing to serve on the committee, of course). Senators will vote for 5 names from the list on a paper ballot, one ballot per attending Senator. The 5 names from the list garnering the most votes will be put forward to the Presidential search committee for further consideration. Any ties will be broken by a run-off paper ballot vote in the Faculty Senate meeting on 3/8/16.

The Faculty Senate feels this is the most transparent and inclusive way of garnering faculty input on our desired Presidential search committee members. Your Senators value your opinions and thoughts and wish to get your nominations for this important process.
