The University of Central Arkansas has entered into consortium agreements with other institutions of higher learning to enhance the educational opportunities of students participating in the program(s) covered in the agreement. UCA currently has two consortium agreements, which are listed below. The "Home" institution is the school that is designated to process financial aid applications for otherwise eligible students.

Financial Aid Eligibility

In order to apply for federal financial aid, all students must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and request that the results be sent to the Home Institution.
