

Financial Aid Packaging Policy 21/22

It is the policy of the UCA Office of Student Financial Aid to package financial aid for admitted students in accordance with established federal, state and institutional guidelines.

Initial awards made prior to the start of the award year assume full time enrollment. The scheduled academic year is used to determine eligibility and consists of fall, spring, summer, with summer always considered a trailer.

A student federal financial aid package is built in the order below, if the particular funding is known.

- 1. State Financial Aid Resources (ADHE)
- 2. Federal Pell Grant
- 3. Private Financial Aid Resources (including Contracts)
- 4. Institutional Financial Aid Resources
- 5. Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant (SEOG)
- 6. Federal Direct Subsidized Loan (DSUB)
- 7. Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan (UNSUB)
- 8. Federal Work Study (FWS)
- 9. Federal Direct Parent Loan for Undergraduate Students (PLUS)
- 10. Federal Direct Loan for Graduate Students (GPLUS)
