

# UCA Consortium/Contractual Agreements

The University of Central Arkansas has consortium and contractual agreements with other institutions of higher education to enhance the educational opportunities of student participating in the program(s) covered in the agreement. UCA currently has two agreements which are listed below.

The “Home” institution is the school that is designated to award the degree or certificate and to process financial aid applications for otherwise eligible students.

## Financial Aid Eligibility

In order to apply for federal financial aid, all students must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and request that the results be sent to UCA. The UCA school code is 001092.

If needed, UCA will request other documents and information. Once the FAFSA is completed, it is always a good idea to follow up with the Financial Aid Office at the Home Institution.

Note: If you are receiving a UCA institutional scholarship, once you transition to the host school, you will not longer be able to receive your scholarship for tuition/fees paid to the other school. If you receive a housing scholarship as part of your UCA institutional scholarship, once you transition to the host school, you will be eligible for the housing portion of the scholarship if you stay in UCA institutional housing.
